F Instruments - Upper Octave - "Ab" Scale



On this sheet, we will introduce 16th note/8th note combinations with rests.. This means that within 1 beat, there may be both 8th notes and 16th notes and rests.

Remember that 8th notes are counted 1+2+3+4+.

Remember that 16th notes are counted 1-e+-a-2-e+-a-3-e+-a-4-e+-a.

The rests are labeled exactly the same, except the label goes above the note.

A 16th note rest looks like an 8th note rest with a 2nd flag hanging off it.
