F Inst - Upper - Ab Scale



Time signatures tell us what rhythmic values to play on the notes we play.

The rules of 4/4 time tell us that a quarter note = 1 beat and there are 4 beats per measure.

All of the following time signatures have a 4 as the bottom number, meaning the quarter note is still 1 beat.

The top number changes, which means we will alter the number of beats in each measure.
