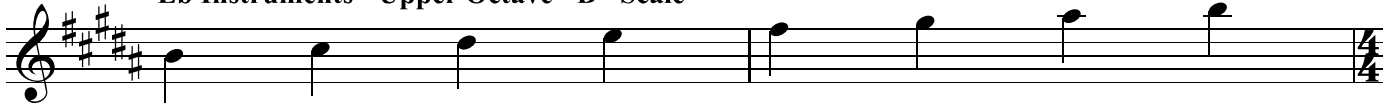


# D SIGHT-READING + RHYTHM EXERCISES

## Level 1

### E♭ Instruments - Upper Octave "B" Scale



The sixteenth note is worth 1/4 of a beat, which means four 16th notes would be equivalent to 1 full beat.

If you see four 16th notes in a row () they would be labeled "# e + a."

This would be spoken "One-Eee-And-Uh."

The "1" can be replaced by 2, 3, 4 - depending on where it lies in the measure.
